### Pass sound state energy policies in the 2010 state legislature.

In 2010, Kentucky should pass legislation that establishes a renewable and efficiency portfolio standard and feed-in tariffs for in-state renewable energy production.

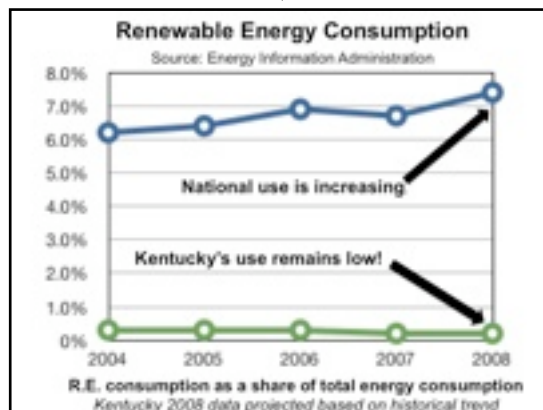
### 2020 Goal - Energy Efficiency

Offset 10.25% of statewide cumulative electricity use through new energy efficiency savings by 2020.

### 2020 Goal - Renewable Energy

Increase Kentucky's use of clean, renewable electricity sources from 1.7% in 2007 to 12.5% in 2020.
